PRESIDENT'S REPORT

To all Players past & present, Families, Members & Life Members.

Firstly, thanks to all associated with Macleod Junior Football Club for making me feel so welcome and supported through my first year as president. I took on this role on the belief that we had a great team of committed volunteers and supporters around the club who would help spread the workload, and this was certainly the case.

Work on the 2017 season began immediately following the 2016 AGM, with all-new executive committee and returning members of the general committee getting straight to work on player and coach recruitment. Having strong numbers in Auskick thanks to the great leadership of Tom Barca and Paul Skaife gives us an avenue to strong growth in younger age groups, but we also ran a number of school-based clinics and attended local community events to ensure Macleod JFC was top-of-mind for players of all ages as they came to registering for the 2017 season.

By February 2017, we had surpassed our total 2016 registration number of 132, and charged on to a total of 192 registered players in 2017.

We started 2017 with 10 teams (U8 x2, U9 x 2, U10, U11, U12, U14, and Colts x 2). Unfortunately, our Colts Div 5 forfeited the later part of the season due to lack of numbers, however I'd like to make special mention to Andrew Williams, Eddie Lawson, and the committed playing group who did all they did to keep the team running. Thanks also to Dean Harrington for providing opportunities to all available players to continue to train and play.

The committee also made an effort to reinvest in the membership by providing free sports bags to each registered player, all while keeping registration fees to a low \$210. We also made significant investment in new playing jumpers to ensure common sponsorship branding, and continued to host regular family nights, registration events, Auskick BBQs, and Presentation Day – all provided at no additional cost to families.

Sponsorship – and providing value to sponsors – was also a key focus, with a number of new major sponsors coming on board. Sponsors were provided with additional exposure through new fence signage, advertising in Eagle Talk, and online promotions. Thanks must go to the following key sponsors:

Along with increased sponsorship, we also had an increase across all areas such as fund raising, canteen income, and bar income. While this is attributed in part to the increase in membership, thanks also must go to our canteen manager – Fiona Sherwill – who took on the role in 2017, and bar manager Mark Medley.

We went live with our online store early in the year, allowing people to transact with the club via our website. This greatly reduced the workload on individuals to handle the various

transactions, and also helped with our stock and financial reporting. This focus will continue through 2018.

I'd like to acknowledge the Macleod Football Club and their president, Mark Lynch, for the support they showed throughout 2017. MJFC provides a vital pathway to senior football, and we will further foster this relationship in the coming years.

In the tradition of developing elite footballers, it was pleasing to see Caleb Karavas (under 12) selected for the Victorian Primary Schools team, and Evan Tsitsis (Colts) debut for Northern Knights in the TAC Cup. We look forward to seeing their continued development.

Success of a junior football club must be measured in more than simply match results. My focus this year as president, and that of the committee, was to ensure we put in place the right structures and environment for children to develop their football skills and have fun playing the game. This also aligned to our expectations and education of coaches to ensure these standards were held throughout the club. Having had a solid year of off field development and growth, we are confident this will translate to increased on field success in 2018.

Our 2017 Thanks Night was held in October, where it was an honor to have John and Norma Beever attend to present the 2017 Beever Family Award to long time club helper, Gavan Dougherty. This was a well-deserved reward for years of support around the club, including helping raised \$1000's by hosting the annual Trivia Night.

2018 is going to be a big year in the history of Macleod JFC, marking our 50th Anniversary. The 2017 committee is already planning for the year ahead, and I look forward to continuing in my current role through 2018, and hope to welcome a number of new faces to the committee. With that said, a huge thanks must go to all the committee members listed in the front of this report. The one thing every one of us has in common is a passion to see Macleod JFC be a great junior football club, and a willingness to get the job done. Without this small group of volunteers, we simply would not have a club.

Regular coaches meetings were also held where a lot of constructive communication and interaction occurred. Many strategies and philosophies were discussed including game day processes, training drills as well as coaching philosophies and techniques.

In finishing, I would like to thank the contribution and efforts of my fellow Football Department members Nick Vas and Dean Harrington. Your knowledge, expertise and experience has been a valuable asset to our club.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Planning for 2017 started soon after the 2016 AGM and off-season events such as the Malahang Community Festival, Macleod Movie Night BBQ and Bunnings Sausage Sizzle Fund raiser kept the committee and other volunteers busy. Following a busy registration day and recruitment drive, MJFC fielded 10 teams in the Yarra Junior Football League (YJFL). Our Auskick program continued to grow increasing to incredible levels of over 150 children in 2017.

One major change for 2017 was the introduction of an online compliance tool BlueQ. YJFL stipulated the mandatory usage of this tool to allow them full visibility of every club's accreditation levels. Roles with accreditation requirements included: Coach, Assistant Coach, Trainer Up to Under 12, Trainer Under 13 & up, President, Vice President, Secretary, Team Manager, Runner and Canteen Supervisor. This required that over 50 volunteers undertaking these roles have BlueQ accounts created and their accreditations, such as Working with Children Check, First Aid, CPR, Coaching and Code of Conduct, saved within the system. I am pleased to report, with assistance from all volunteers concerned, that MJFC achieved an outstanding result of 98% organisational compliance.

An unfortunate consequence of playing a contact sport is that sometimes players suffer injuries with the potential for significant medical costs. The committee once again took the decision to take out Platinum level insurance above the normal YJFL basic cover allowing 90% of all non-Medicare costs reimbursed up to a max of \$7,500.

YJFL continued to expand growing to an impressive 477 teams. This put pressure on the umpires department and necessitated that each club provide an umpire for the u10's competition at all home games. Departing treasurer Eamon Bourke volunteered for this role and did a fantastic job, often receiving praise from the opposition team and spectators for his constant feedback to the players on decisions taken.

One of the more difficult parent roles to fill within a team is that of Trainer. The main challenges include the requirement for a current first aid training certificate, current CPR accreditation (renewable annually) and the responsibility that comes with performing the role. The club continued to fund any first aid training for those in need and also organised a CPR course at Macleod Park for the convenience of those in need of the annual refresher.

The committee continued to work well with the Banyule City Council. Following a detailed application and assessment process, MJFC were awarded exclusive pavilion and ground use at Macleod Park and Winsor Reserve across the 2017 & 2018 seasons. An amazing achievement of the previous committee was obtaining funding of \$215,000 over the 2016/17 financial year for roof repairs, storm water draining replacements and Carpark Asphalt Sealing project. The latter deliverable was completed in 2017 and we even managed to get a part fence replacement thrown in.

Taking on the secretary role in 2017, it was a year of steep learning, akin to understanding the ins and outs of running a small business. Thanks to Rino Corelli, departing secretary, for guiding me throughout the year and continuing to perform several activities in an assistant capacity. This succession planning approach worked well and is a model that ideally is adopted into the future.

This year's committee was made up of many new faces which resulted in new ideas and renewed enthusiasm. Our committee was passionate and committed to the club; this was often demonstrated and evident in all the hard work that went into the seasons organizing of events, game day support roles and all the hard work that went on behind the scenes.

The clubs sign up day in February and our fantastic Presentation day in September, and three weeks of hosting finals reflected on how dedicated the committee and its members were in making these days possible.

I would like to thank any retiring committee members and welcome all next year's committee members as planning begins for a huge 2018 season. To all our wonderful: players, parents, volunteer's and sponsors, a big thank you for being part of the MACLEOD JUNIOR FOOTBALL CLUB family. In particular, I would like to single out the President, Paul Starmans, for his leadership and the incredible number of hours he has committed to building an outstanding club for the enjoyment and benefit of all our children.

TREASURER'S REPORT

This season saw us start to reverse our struggling playing numbers to achieve growth in club membership numbers from the previous season from 144 to 193 members, although we still have approximately 10% not financial. These members will continue to be reminded that their fees are overdue and payable.

Much of this increase in playing numbers can be attributed to the continuing growth in Auskick at Macleod headed up by Tom Barca along with the hard work of both the outgoing and incoming executive committee in their tireless pursuit to make our club healthy and viable. Also the huge voluntary efforts from parents and stalwarts of the club are both extremely necessary and greatly appreciated.

We saw increased revenue on the previous year in nearly all of our key income streams such as canteen, membership fees, merchandise sales and sponsorship. It should be pointed out that this year's profit and loss statement has the revenue and expenses of the social nights combined with the bar. It is worth noting that each social night ran at a profit with the Trivia Night being our most successful. Thank you to all of those committee and non-committee members who helped put those functions together.

Overall revenue for the club increased by 10% on the previous year with membership takings increasing by 25%. However, membership fees only accounted for 26.5% of the total revenue raised. This means we remain heavily reliant on other income streams to keep the club financially viable. We need to continue to grow our membership base to ensure the long term survival of the MJFC.

With regard to the finances of the football club, the bottom line is that we made a small net operating profit of \$8,756 for the year, up 19.2% on the previous year, which is encouraging as we look to the future and hope to be able to make further improvements to our club and facilities over time.

The club's financial position remains healthy and shows a positive future outlook. As at September 30, 2017 the transaction accounts held a balance of \$47,468.90 with very little outstanding debt. Our greatest challenges still lie in our ability to continue to increase our playing base.

A lot of Auskickers will go on to play in our underage teams next year, ensuring that the Junior club will have a steady flow of players coming through in the next few years and beyond.

If this year was big, let's make next year the best ever, with it being The clubs 50th Anniversary. The future looks rosy, and I thank everyone involved for all the help and support this season. Bring on 2018!!
